2. The feedback on curriculum was taken from the students of all years, Teachers, Alumni and Employers at the end of each academic year.


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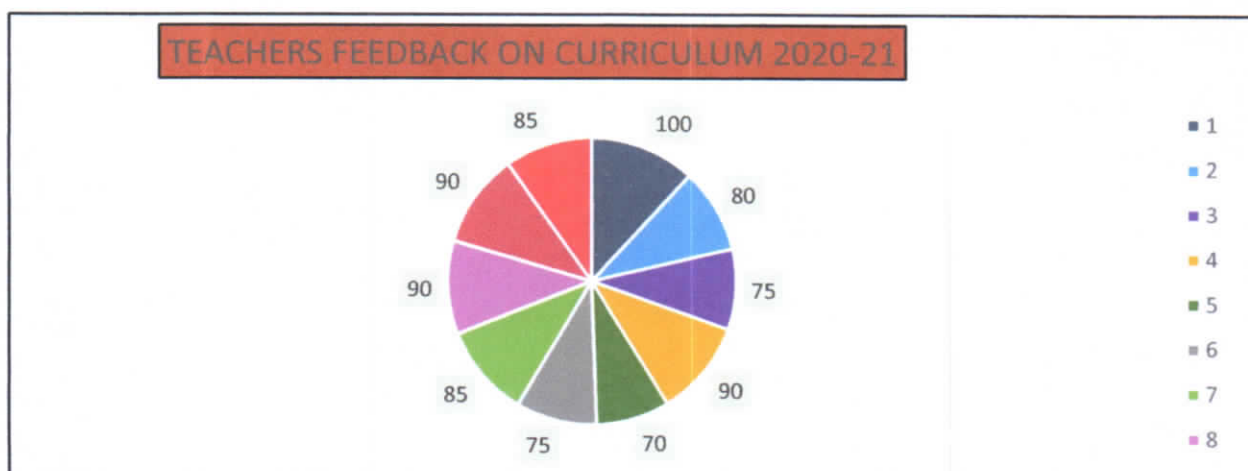
