St. Johns College of Engineering & Technology, Yerrakota (V), Yemmiganur - 518360, Kurnool Dt., Andhra Pradesh, India having expertise in the areas of Scientific, Technological Education and Research, established in 2001 hereinafter referred to as SJCET, of the FIRST PART,

AND

Bhimavaram Institute Of Engineering and Technology having office at Goraganamudi (V)- 534243, Palakoderu (Md.), West Godavari Dt., Andhra Pradesh, India hereinafter referred to as BIET, of the SECOND PART, for the purpose of student's collaboration, faculty and staff collaboration in the academic and research activities.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as institutes.

PREAMBLE:

WHEREAS, SJCET and BIET have many areas of common interest in Engineering and Sciences, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of administration, academics, education and research.

NOW THEREFORE, SJCET and BIET have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions set out in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECTIVES

Both Institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

A. Research

1. Collaboration research and development, patents and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest.
2. Undertaking joint research
3. Co-supervising post-graduate students.
4. Conducting joint consultancy work.
5. to propose and engage jointly in research or training programs sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein

B. Academics

1. The exchange of academic materials and publications.
2. Conducting lectures on specialized topics
3. Attachment of faculty for purposes of curriculum development and review, upgrading of teaching and research skills.
4. Participating in seminars, symposiums, and other types of academic discussions.
5. to organize jointly seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
6. to jointly organize short-term continuing education programs on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
7. to use laboratory facilities in specific cases for a limited period
8. to conduct add-on/ certificate/ faculty development programs of their mutual interest.

C. Education

1. Conducting lectures on teaching learning process
2. to exchange information on research and educational programs.
3. to exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programs

D. Administration and Others

1. the provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff and students of both institutes
2. Mutual cooperation in accreditation NAAC, NBA process
3. Mutual cooperation in training in administrative activities

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity; setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration will be agreed. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment or such exchange, including those concerning salary, travel funding, health insurance, and housing will be worked out between the institutes.

SJCET and BIET agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a programme coordinator from the side of SJ CET, and a programme coordinator from the side of BIET, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

SJ CET and BIET does not absolve any confidential information during the research activity.

ARTICLE 4: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Ownership of any intellectual property (including but not limited to confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software, and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MOU shall be vested in both institutes to this Memorandum. Both institutes shall have the joint right to determine the commercial exploitation and disposition of such intellectual property, and both institutes shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Before any registration or commercialization of any intellectual property takes place, the institutes agree to reach a separate agreement covering issues such as exploitation rights and revenue sharing. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall only be possible with the prior written consent of both institutes, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld. The institutes shall be free to use perpetually the results arising out of the collaborating activities for its own internal teaching, research, educational, clinical and publication purposes without the payment of royalties or other fees to the other party.

ARTICLE 5: VALIDITY

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of **ONE** year commencing from effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

ARTICLE 6: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of six months in advance to the other institution. Once terminated, neither SJ CET nor BIET will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, SJ CET and BIET will ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

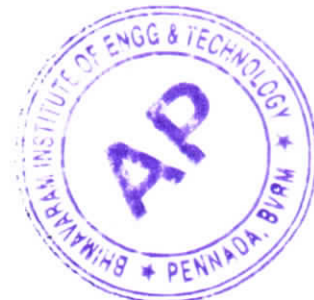

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This memorandum of understanding (MoU) is executed on 7TH OCTOBER 2020

By and Between

Dist represented by its principal **Dr.K.SURESH** (Hereinafter refer to as “BIET”, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean & include its successors & assigns) being the party of first part

And

Potti Sriramulu Chalavadi Mallikarjunarao College Of Engineering & Technology Having Its Registered Office At 7-3-6/1 Raghvareddy Street Kothapeta, Vijayawada Andhra Pradesh 520001, represented by its principal **Dr.K. SRI RAMA KRISHNA** (Hereinafter refer to as “PSCMRCET”, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean & include its successors & assigns) being the party of second part “BIET” & “PSCMRCET”, are Hereinafter, wherever the context so requires, individually referred to as “party” and collectively as “parties”.

Whereas:

- A. BIET is engaged in service of engineering & technical education with the college name referred as Bhimavaram Institute of Engineering and Technology, Swamy Jnanananda Ashram Road, Pennada-534243, Palakoderu Mandal, W.G. Dist.
- B. PSCMRCET is engaged in service of engineering & technical education with college name referred as Potti Sriramulu Chalavadi Mallikarjunarao College Of Engineering & Technology in the city of Vijayawada.

Objectives of MoU:

- A. To promote & enhance academic interest between BIET and PSCMRCET.
- B. To provide advice for implementation of quality of education between BIET and PSCMRCET.
- C. To promote research/continuing education activities between parties.

Technical areas of collaboration:

- A. A continuing quality improvement programme to improve quality of teaching staff in both parties.
- B. Providing academic interaction by delivering special lectures at both institutes on topics of relevance to modern industry.
- C. Provide necessary helps in organizing workshops, conferences and personality development programmes at both parties for enhancement of skills in respect of faculty, staff and students.
- D. Provides necessary support for establishment of video satellite link and assistance in development of E-classrooms, Lab, Curriculum, Establishment of research labs, training and placement, library etc. at both parties.
- E. To provide training programmes for Students & Staff.

Proposed modes of collaboration:

BIET & PSCMRCET proposed to collaborate through the following:

- A. Cooperation and promotion of education and training in areas of mutual interest.
- B. Any other appropriate mode of interest agreed upon between BIET & PSCMRCET

A specific plan will be worked out by the parties depending upon availability of resources. A specific agreement will be entered in to for each activity.

Terms & conditions:

- A. The cost of development of infrastructure at both parties should be borne by themselves.

- B. For continuing education to teachers and students the financial arrangements will be made mutually agreed terms.
- C. For the visits related to advice & consultancy, travel and other expenses of faculty & staff shall be reimbursed by both the parties on mutually agreed terms.
- D. The faculty and students of both parties can use library facilities for a short time.
- E. Both parties agreed to help identify and invite the faculty members & researchers from the other institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses.
- F. This MoU may be amended, removed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time.
- G. Either party should have the right to terminate this MoU upon 60days prior written notice to the other Party.

Confidentiality:

- A. The BIET and the PSCMRCET agreed to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the parties as being confidential which is obtained from either party or created during the performance of MOU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other party.
- B. The above confidential clause under this MOU excludes the information/data processed by either party before entering into this MOU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

Duration of MOU:

This MOU unless extended by mutual written consent of the parties, shall expires in one year after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. However, in review the MOU shall be extended for another two years by mutual consent.

Force majeure:

Neither party shall be liable for any failure or delay in its performance due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control, provided that it notifies the other party as soon as practicable and uses its best efforts to resume performance.

Indemnity:

Each party shall indemnify and keep indemnified, defend and hold harmless the other party and their respective officers, directors, employees (collectively the "indemnified persons") from and against any and all direct losses, claims, costs, liabilities, judgments, expenses or damages that the indemnified person may incur or suffer as a result of or arising out of breach of any representation made by it under this agreement.

Severability:

If any part or any provision of this MOU becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that part or provision shall be ineffective to the extent of invalidity or unenforceability without in any way affecting the validity or enforceability of the remaining parts of said provision of this MOU. The parties hereby agree to attempt to substitute any invalid or unenforceable provision with a valid or enforceable provision, which achieves to the greatest extent possible the economic, legal and commercial objectives of the invalid or unenforceable provision.

Assignment:

The parties to the agreement shall not assign or support to assign or otherwise deal with any of its rights and obligations hereunder without the prior written consent of the other party.

Waiver:

Failure of party to exercise promptly any option or right granted, or to require strict performance of any obligation herein imposed shall not be deemed to be a waiver of such rights or of the right to demand subsequent performance of any and all obligations herein imposed.

Amendments:

All changes and amendments to this agreement or to any attachment there to be valid only if made in writing and signed by duly authorized representatives of both the parties.

Dispute resolution:

In the event of any disputes, differences or controversies arises between the parties, hereto, out of, or in relation to or in connection with provisions of this MOU or any action taken hereunder, the parties hereto shall thoroughly explore all possibilities for an amicable settlement. In case the amicable settlement cannot be reached, disputes, differences or controversies shall be referred to sole arbitrator appointment with the mutual consent of both the parties in accordance with the provisions of the arbitration and conciliation Act-1996, and the venue of such arbitration shall be Vijayawada and the proceedings shall be conducted in English. the award of the arbitrator/arbitrary tribunal shall be final and binding on both the parties hereto.

Jurisdiction:

This agreement shall be governed and construed by and in accordance with the laws of India and subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Vijayawada and Bhimavaram.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective as of 25-09-2020 (Effective Date) to establish an affiliation by and between

St. Johns College of Engineering & Technology, Yerrakota (V), Yemmiganur - 518360, Kurnool Dt., Andhra Pradesh, India having expertise in the areas of Scientific, Technological Education and Research, established in 2001 hereinafter referred to as SJ CET, of the FIRST PART,

AND

Bhimavaram Institute Of Engineering and Technology having office at Goraganamudi (V)- 534243, Palakoderu (Md.), West Godavari Dt., Andhra Pradesh, India hereinafter referred to as BIET, of the SECOND PART, for the purpose of student's collaboration, faculty and staff collaboration in the academic and research activities.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as institutes.

PREAMBLE:

WHEREAS, SJ CET and BIET have many areas of common interest in Engineering and Sciences, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of administration, academics, education and research.

NOW THEREFORE, SJ CET and BIET have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions set out in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECTIVES

Both Institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

A. Research

2. Undertaking joint research

4. Conducting joint consultancy work.
5. to propose and engage jointly in research or training programs sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein

B. Academics

1. The exchange of academic materials and publications.
2. Conducting lectures on specialized topics
3. Attachment of faculty for purposes of curriculum development and review, upgrading of teaching and research skills.
4. Participating in seminars, symposiums, and other types of academic discussions.
5. to organize jointly seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
6. to jointly organize short-term continuing education programs on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
7. to use laboratory facilities in specific cases for a limited period
8. to conduct add-on/ certificate/ faculty development programs of their mutual interest.

C. Education

1. Conducting lectures on teaching learning process
2. to exchange information on research and educational programs.
3. to exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programs

D. Administration and Others

1. the provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff and students of both institutes
2. Mutual cooperation in accreditation NAAC, NBA process
3. Mutual cooperation in training in administrative activities

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity; setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration will be agreed. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment or such exchange, including those concerning salary, travel funding, health insurance, and housing will be worked out between the institutes.

SJCET and BIET agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a programme coordinator from the side of SJ CET, and a programme coordinator from the side of BIET, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

SJ CET and BIET does not absolve any confidential information during the research activity.

ARTICLE 4: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Ownership of any intellectual property (including but not limited to confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software, and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MOU shall be vested in both institutes to this Memorandum. Both institutes shall have the joint right to determine the commercial exploitation and disposition of such intellectual property, and both institutes shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Before any registration or commercialization of any intellectual property takes place, the institutes agree to reach a separate agreement covering issues such as exploitation rights and revenue sharing. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall only be possible with the prior written consent of both institutes, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld. The institutes shall be free to use perpetually the results arising out of the collaborating activities for its own internal teaching, research, educational, clinical and publication purposes without the payment of royalties or other fees to the other party.

ARTICLE 5: VALIDITY

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of **ONE** year commencing from effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

ARTICLE 6: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of six months in advance to the other institution. Once terminated, neither SJ CET nor BIET will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. 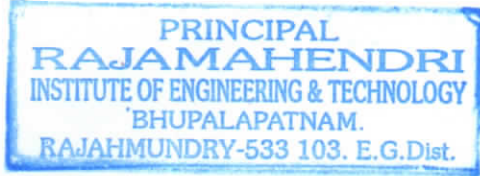

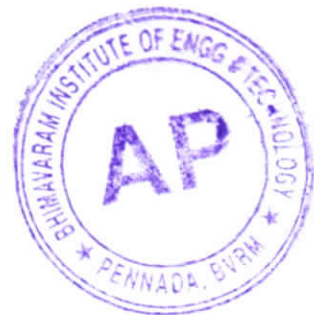

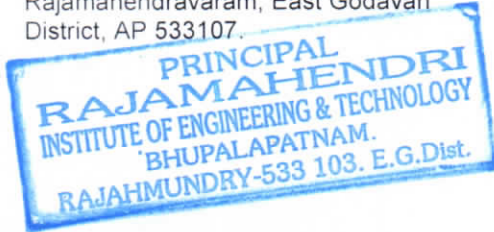

Along with academics the institution focuses on different disciplines to make the students multi-faceted technocrats.

Objectives of MoU:

1. To promote & enhance academic interest between **VITW** and **BIET**.
2. To provide advice for implementation of quality of education between **VITW** and **BIET**.
3. To promote research/continuing education activities between parties.
4. Access to Information on research / education resources and academics.
5. Access to Centers of Excellence of the college
6. Technical support in projects related to science and management from senior faculty or experts
7. Guidance for specific issues in terms of R&D, Project design and development etc. from the senior faculty or experts
8. On boarding potential faculty who would be the mentors to support boot camps, Technology Readiness Level (TRL) activities for prototyping, guide startups on pro bono basis
9. To refer or depute faculty or Resource persons for specific programs as speakers.

Technical areas of collaboration:

- A. A continuing quality improvement programme to improve quality of teaching staff in both parties.
- B. Providing academic interaction by delivering special lectures at both institutes on topics of relevance to modern industry.
- C. Provide necessary helps in organizing workshops, conferences and personality development programmes at both parties for enhancement of skills in respect of faculty, staff and students.
- D. Provides necessary support for establishment of video satellite link and assistance in development of E-classrooms, Lab, Curriculum, Establishment of research labs, training and placement, library etc. at both parties.
- E. To provide training programmes for Students & Staff.

Terms & conditions:

- 1. The cost of development of infrastructure at both parties should be borne by themselves.
- 2. For continuing education to teachers and students the financial arrangements will be made mutually agreed terms.
- 3. For the visits related to advice & consultancy, travel and other expenses of faculty & staff shall be reimbursed by both the parties on mutually agreed terms.
- 4. The faculty and students of both parties can use library facilities for a short time.
- 5. Both parties agreed to help identify and invite the faculty members & researchers from the other institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses.
- 6. This MoU may be amended, removed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time.
- 7. Either party should have the right to terminate this MoU upon 60days prior written notice to the other Party.

A. Confidentiality: The VITW and the BIET agreed to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the parties as being confidential which is obtained from either party or created during the performance of MOU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other party.

The above confidential clause under this MOU excludes the information/data processed by either party before entering into this MOU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

B. Coordination

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

C. Tenure and Termination

This MOU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for one year, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MOU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. However, VITW and BIET will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.

D. Arbitration Clause

Should there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, VITW and will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.

This MOU is signed subject to approval of the respective academic/administrative bodies.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective as of 14th July 2017 to establish an affiliation by and between

Rajamahendri Institute of Engineering & Technology, having office at Bhoopalapatnam (V), Rajamahendravaram-533107, East Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh, India hereinafter referred to as RIET, of the FIRST PARTY,

AND

Bhimavaram Institute Of Engineering and Technology, Goraganamudi (V)- 534243, Palakoderu (Md.), West Godavari Dt., Andhra Pradesh, India having expertise in the areas of Scientific, Technological Education and Research, established in 2007 hereinafter referred to as BIET, of the SECOND PARTY, for the purpose of student's collaboration, faculty and staff collaboration in the academic and research activities.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as institutes.

PREAMBLE:

Whereas, RIET and BIET have many areas of common interest in Engineering and Sciences, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of administration, academics, education and research.

Now Therefore, RIET and BIET have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions set out in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECTIVES

Both Institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

D. Administration and Others

1. The provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff and students of both institutes
2. Mutual cooperation in accreditation NAAC, NBA process
3. Mutual cooperation in training in administrative activities

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity; setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration will be agreed. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment or such exchange, including those concerning salary, travel funding, health insurance, and housing will be worked out between the institutes.

RIET and BIET agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software, and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MOU shall be vested in both institutes to this Memorandum. Both institutes shall have the joint right to determine the commercial exploitation and disposition of such intellectual property, and both institutes shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Before any registration or commercialization of any intellectual property takes place, the institutes agree to reach a separate agreement covering issues such as exploitation rights and revenue sharing.

Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall only be possible with the prior written consent of both institutes, such consent not to be unreasonably withheld. The institutes shall be free to use perpetually the results arising out of the collaborating activities for its own internal teaching, research, educational, clinical and publication purposes without the payment of royalties or other fees to the other party.

ARTICLE 5: VALIDITY

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of **ONE** year commencing from effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

ARTICLE 6: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of six months in advance to the other institution. Once terminated, neither RIET nor BIET will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, RIET and BIET will ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

ARTICLE 7: AMENDMENTS/MODIFICATIONS

This MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both institutes.

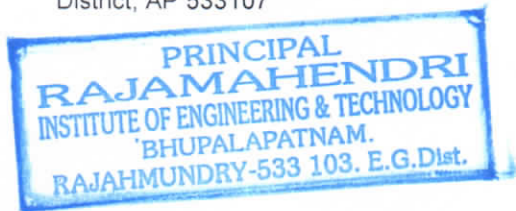
ARTICLE 10: DISPUTE RESOLUTION
